## NOTICE OF MODIFICATION TO PROPOSED REGULATIONS Division 1, Chapter 1 Article 2.0 – Driver's License and Identification Cards Section 20.04 – Information Required for a Name Change on a Driver License or Identification Card

In accordance with Government Code section 11346.8(c), the Department of Motor Vehicles (department) provides this notice for the purpose of inviting comments regarding modification of the proposed regulation related to a name change on a driver's license or identification card.

The regulatory language, as originally proposed, was published in the California Regulatory Notice Register on August 25, 2023, and was provided to interested persons for comment. No comment were received, however, the department is amending the originally proposed text for clarity and to ensure the regulatory text is consistent with the department's practices.

## Comments will be accepted between November 29, 2023 and December 14, 2023.
